- To learn more about God and yourself.

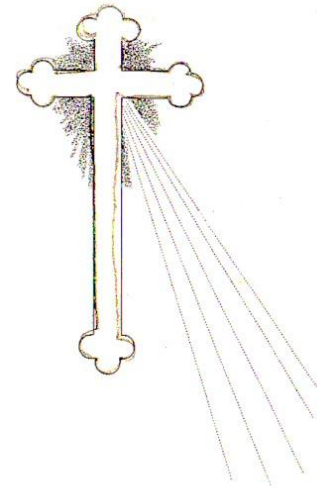
Join us!
